JANKIDEVI EDUCATIONAL TRUST

Jankidevi Public School is the creation of Jankidevi Educational Trust. This Trust was founded by Shri Badri Prasad Jaidev Verma in the year 1991 to realise the dreams and vision of his beloved mother Late Smt. Jankidevi, who took Samadhi on 31st January 1999 at the age of 104 years. She had always nurtured the idea that selfless contribution to society is the hallmark of an individual and this could be done best through educational institutions.

Kindled by her vision the anchor role of shaping her dreams into reality was taken up by her grandson Shri Narendra B. Verma, the founder and chief architect of the school. He began this great endeavour with predetermined efforts and a focus towards understanding the needs of the youth and slowly but steadily building up a dream school which could in essence build up this very elixir of life. He has now set out on the task of making this institution a landmark in the field of education.

Jankidevi Educational Trust holds exemption U/S 80G of the Income Tax act and is registered with the charity commissioner under registration no. E 13351 (Mumbai) dated 6-6-91 as a Public Charitable Trust with the sole aim of establishing schools.

OUR SCHOOL

Jankidevi Public School is a modern educational institution with an international perspective. The school incorporates in its milieu, all that is universally good in thoughts, words and deeds. It stands for secular and ethical values and enlightens the students in a way that permits the students to grow up without any prejudice. The school pursues an academic procedure with a view to ensure excellence in curricular, co-curricular and extra curricular activities. It is our endeavour to make education a meaningful and a pleasant experience.

The school is managed by the Principal, Supervisors, co-ordinators and a well qualified teaching staff. The overall supervision of the school is done by the 'School Committee' comprising of the trustees of Jankidevi Educational Trust, the Director of Education and the Principal. It is guided by the Academic Council which includes The Director of Education, the Educational Consultant, the Principal and the Supervisors.

The school building provides a full fledged infrastructure for curricular and co-curricular activities. It also has a vast campus with facilities which are essential for the all round development of the students. The school maintains a very high standard in terms of modernity and discipline.

The school is affiliated to the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Education for the students of STD. X. It prepares the students for the Secondary School Certificate Examination (S. S. C.) and strictly follows the syllabus prescribed by the Maharashtra Board. The First Batch of Std X will be appearing for the ICSE Board Examination in March 2011. The school has been granted provisional affiliation from the ICSE Council (New Delhi) for Std I-IX.

The IGCSE curriculum Students of ICSE who pass Std. VII & Std. VIII will be given an option either to continue with ICSE or switch over to the Internationally recognized IGCSE curriculum from Cambridge International Examination.

ADMISSION

1. Admission is open to all children without any distinction of sex, race, caste, creed and social status.
2. The age limit prescribed by the government shall be rigidly adhered to and no relaxation in age shall be permitted.
3. Students should be 5½ yrs. of age as on 1st June of the year of admission to Std I. For Std II to X the students should be of corresponding age depending upon the std for which admission is sought.
4. Admission in all classes is subject to availability of seats.
5. Students who join the Pre-Primary section and standard I will have to produce the original birth certificate in support of the date of birth entered in the admission form.
6. Students will not be admitted without the original Leaving Certificate from the school last attended. Till all the required documents specified in the admission form are submitted, the admission stands provisional.
7. Students belonging to SC/ST/OBC etc. must submit caste certificate.
8. Students coming from other states or countries have to get the L.C. counter signed by the Education Officer / Embassy of the same. Changing from CBSE to ICSE, will require permission from the Education Department.
9. Admission will not be given to failures from other schools.
10. **The parent who signs the admission form is considered as the legal guardian of the child.**

FEE STRUCTURE

The school does not receive any grant-in-aid from the government and the only source of income is the amount of fees collected from the students.

PAYMENT OF FEES

- ❖ Admission fee is payable only at the time of admission to each of the sections i.e. Pre-primary, Primary & Secondary.
- ❖ Students of Std VIII and Std IX are exempted from Karate.
- ❖ Students of Std X are exempted from Swimming, Karate and Gym.
- ❖ To ensure safety, the school authorities have arranged that the fees be deposited only into the **school's account** at the **extension counter of the Oriental Bank of Commerce** existing in the school premises. A specially printed pay-in-slip is to be used for this purpose. **Parents must ensure to mention their ward's account number on the pay-in-slip.**
- ❖ Bank Timings:

Mon - Fri	:	9.00 am to 12.30 pm
Sat.	:	9.00 am to 10.30 am
- *❖ Fees must be deposited from 1st June - 30th June and 1st December - 21st December, for the respective term. If the fees are not paid on or before the stipulated last date, strict action will be taken and a late fee will be charged @ Rs. 10/- per day.
- ❖ **School fees should be paid by cheque only, drawn in favour of 'Jankidevi Public School'. Student's name, class, division and contact no. should be written on the reverse of the cheque.**
- ❖ Payment made by cheque is considered final only after its realisation by the bank. Separate receipts are not issued.
- ❖ The school will not be responsible for the loss of cash or cheques sent through children of any age, or for payment made to any member of the staff.
- *❖ In case of non payment of fees only **one reminder** will be given. Parents are requested to send the copy of the fee slip book for verification. The report card will be withheld till the dues are cleared. **If the fees are paid just a week prior to the open house, the wards name is likely to appear in list of defaulters.**

CURRICULUM

For ICSE : **From Std I to IX**

For SSC : **For Std X**

Languages : Languages are taught to improve communication skills both written and spoken. Ability to think on a conceptual plane increases as language ability improves.

English: English is the first language and is the medium of instruction.

Marathi : **For SSC** Marathi is the state language and is compulsory as the second language for students of Std. X.

For ICSE Marathi is compulsory as the third language from Std. IV - VII.

Hindi: **For SSC** Hindi is compulsory as the third language for Std. X.

For ICSE Hindi being the National language, is the compulsory second language from Std. I - X.

Science : To build up the scientific temper and enhance analytical skills among the students, the school emphasises on the practical application of the theoretical concepts. For ICSE, from Std VIII, Science is bifurcated into Physics, Chemistry & Biology.

Mathematics: To increase the student's logical and problem solving abilities.

Social Studies : **Std. III, IV & V** To develop historical perspective of the contributions made by the various cultures to the total heritage of mankind.

To develop and understanding of terms, concepts and principles related to Geography.

History : **For ICSE, Std VI To X** To enable the students to understand the past in the light of present to make a better future.

Civics : To understand the ideals laid down by the Indian Constitution and its application in day to day life to shape the character of patriotic citizens of tomorrow.

Geography :	To show the students the inter-dependence and symbiotic relationship between man and his environment.
Economics :	For SSC To understand the basics of National and International economy.
Environmental Education :	For ICSE, Std. I to X To acquire knowledge about environment, its elements, ecosystems and their interrelation helping students develop the habit of making judicious utilization of resources and materials for maintaining the balance in nature.
Information Technology :	For ICSE, Std. I to VIII To acquaint the students with the computer as a useful tool which increases efficiency, inter-connectivity and thereby the productivity of the students.
Elocution & Conversational Skills (Language Development Programme) :	For ICSE, Std. I to VIII Aims at the improvement of the language, by enriching the vocabulary, Pronunciation, grammar and voice with due emphasis on etiquettes and mannerisms.
Fine Arts :	To train the students to display their talents, feelings and creative abilities through Art, Craft, Music, Dance etc.
Personality : Development	For SSC To enable students to deal effectively with the demands of everyday life by developing adaptive and positive behaviour.
Physical Education :	For ICSE, Std. I to VIII It has been rightly said that a healthy body nurtures a healthy mind. In view of this, great stress is laid on Physical Training, Yoga, Exercises in Gymnasium, Swimming, Games, Sports etc. A written exam for Physical Education is compulsory for Std. SSC.
Hobby Classes :	Students are given opportunities to learn instrumental Music, Public Speaking, Skating, Cricket, Foot ball, Basket ball Joy of Reading, Vedic Math, IIT Preparations and Martial arts under the guidance of professional instructors and coaches.

Value Education : Moral and ethical values constitute an important part of the course in context of the prevailing value crisis in the society.

General : Knowledge General awareness and knowledge about current affairs.

Library : To inculcate a love for reading, students are given access to the library an important centre for learning.

For Check Point & IGCSE

The IGCSE Curriculum emphasizes on the development of habits of critical inquiry and individual research and encourages a problem-solving approach to what one has learnt.

The assessment process goes beyond the recall of knowledge, emphasizing on skills like student's ability to use and apply knowledge appropriately, use information to solve problems and acquire experimental and investigative skills.

An encouragement to go beyond rote learning or memorization is the key in all IGCSE syllabi.

The development of skills of application, analysis, evaluation and creation become important in encouraging students who are able to take their learning beyond the confines of the classroom and examination hall.

The IGCSE approach is rooted in active learning and its assessment models have been designed to reflect this orientation. They include not only terminal examinations but also the assessment of fieldwork or practical investigations in the lab, oral and listening skills in foreign and second languages, and project or coursework completed during the study period.

The key criterion is 'fitness for purpose' and skills are assessed in the most appropriate way possible.

Check Point Class VIII Students have the following Subjects:

- **Languages** : English as first language and Hindi / French as second language
- **Science** : Physics, Chemistry, Biology
- **Mathematics**
- The students are also offered, swimming, gymnasium, IT, PT and karate

IBDP **(International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme)**

The school also offers IBDP an inquiry-based & student oriented course of study for the Grades XI & XII, which promotes international mindedness by giving broad based education. It is affiliated to International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO, Geneva-Switzerland). The certificate is recognized all over the world to join professional courses or degree courses in Universities in India or abroad.

The Association of Indian Universities (AIU) recognizes the IB Diploma as equivalent to Ten plus Two (10+2) Class of the Senior Secondary School, which is the eligibility criteria for admission to the undergraduate courses in Universities in India. International Baccalaureate Organization issues marksheets with exact marks for the IB students in India who intend to apply to Indian universities. Good IB Diploma scores can get students to receive course credits at many colleges and Universities abroad. All teachers in IB World Schools have access to on-line curriculum centres. There are about 2000 IB schools, in 124 countries. Question papers come from Geneva, and the answer booklets are checked there.

EXAMINATIONS

1. For ICSE and SSC

- Continuous and comprehensive evaluation system exists from Std. I to Std. IX, which is based on class tests, internal assessment, project work and orals along with three terminal examinations.
- Students absent for any examinations for any reason whatsoever, will not be re-examined.
- Absence from examination for any subject (oral or written) involves loss of marks for the subject which will automatically affect the students standing in the merit order.
- **A student found resorting to unfair means in an examination or test will be assigned zero marks in that subject.** Infringement of the rules of examination by any student will make the student liable to punishment or the student may have to leave the school.
- A student who is detained twice in the same class will have to discontinue his studies in the school.

The school gives exposure to the following competitive exams:

- a) Science Olympiad - III to IX (Nov.)
 - b) Marathi Public Exam for Std X (Dec.)
 - c) Cyber Olympiad - V to IX (Sept.)
 - d) Maths Olympiad - III to IX (Dec.)
 - e) Asset Tests for English, Mathematics, Science - III to VIII (August)
- School may conduct extra coaching classes for academic subjects during Diwali and May vacations, for which students will be intimated in advance.
 - Interschool competitions organised by the ICSE schools will be informed during the course of the year.
- ### 2. For IGCSE and IBDP the examination pattern will be modelled on the lines of CIE and IBO.

HOUSE SYSTEM

The school has a four house structure. The students are allotted one of the 4 houses at the time of admission & they remain in the same throughout their school tenure. The main objective of the house system is to inculcate a sense of **unity** and **pride**. It also develops a sense of **collective responsibility** that motivates them to try their best to promote their house in all **Inter-House** competitions.

The four houses are named after four ancient icons who exemplified '**success**', '**dharma**', '**sacrifice**' and '**excellence**'.

- ARJUNA** (Red) : Who proved that 'success' is possible only with unflinching dedication and a strong will to learn.
- KARNA** (Blue) : Who upheld the 'dharma' of commitment to a friend.
- EKLAVYA** (Green) : Who symbolised 'sacrifice'. His love and dedication for his teacher is unparalleled in history.
- ABHIMANYU** (Yellow) : Who proved that 'excellence' can be achieved even in a short span of time which is indicative of his extraordinary grasping ability.

Each house is headed by a House Mistress / House Master, assisted by Captain, Vice Captain and Sports leader.

The system of Prefectoral - Council, managing the four houses helps to develop a spirit of **team work** and **co-ordination**.

UNIFORM SPECIFICATIONS

The school uniform has to be obtained from the authorized dealer only, as the fabric and the colour is specially manufactured for Jankidevi Public School. Also, only these agencies are authorized to use the school monogram.

- Pre-Primary students will wear sports uniform on every Thursday.
- Primary and Secondary students will wear sports uniform on the days they have Gym, PT and Swimming as given in the time table.
- All students must wear clean and ironed uniforms during school hours, Open house and Contact days.
- Hair should not cover the forehead of either boys or girls. Girls having long hair should have it plaited (2 plaits) and tied with black rubber bands. For boys the hair should be cut well above the collar.
- Only BLACK Cardigans will be allowed during winter.
- OFF WHITE turbans will be allowed for Boys from the Sikh Community.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

WITHDRAWAL :

1. Parent's / Guardian's, applications for school leaving certificate should reach the admin. office latest by 31st of May. **After the stipulated date (31st May), tuition fees for the entire month will be charged depending on the date of application.**
2. Leaving Certificate will be issued 20 days after the submission of the application, and after checking the fees records / other dues.

ABSENCE / LEAVE :

1. **Student's name will be struck off the roll, if he/she remains absent without intimation for more than seven consecutive days.**
2. In case the parents apply to the school to readmit the student, the same will be considered under the following terms and conditions
 - a. For absence (of more than seven days upto one month) without any intimation the student will be readmitted on payment Renewal Fees of Rs. 2000/-
 - b. In case the absence is more than one month, formalities of Re-admission will have to be complied with.

*** DISCIPLINE :**

- **Parents visiting school must carry an ID Card.**
1. Pupils should be courteous, respectful and considerate towards fellow students and staff and take full responsibility for their actions so as to uphold the good name of the school.
 2. Pupils are expected to maintain a high standard of good conduct and behaviour. Offensive languages will not be accepted.
 3. The school does not accept the responsibility for the loss of books, pens, money etc. Each child is responsible for his / her own belongings.
 4. Students are expected to keep their classrooms as well as the school campus neat and clean. Proper care must be taken of school property and its belongings. Damage of any kind of the school property must be made good by the offender.
 5. To maintain a certain level of proficiency of the English language, students are expected to speak in English.

6. Silence must be maintained during class hours. Movement from one class to another should be in a disciplined and orderly manner.
7. Chewing of gum is forbidden in the school premises.
8. All students are expected to be within the school premises at least five minutes before the first bell and disciplinary action will be taken against the late comers. Late comers will not be allowed to enter the school during exam.
9. The school calendar must be brought to the school everyday. Parents are requested to read and check the remarks column regularly.
10. No academic queries will be entertained on the telephone.
11. In Pre-Primary and Primary Sections, distribution of sweets on birthdays is restricted to candies only.
12. No student of the school is permitted to take private tuitions from the teacher of the school. The student of Std. X are allowed only after filling up a prescribed form available with the supervisor.
13. Whatever be the arrangement, no private tuitions are allowed on the school premises. For any act of indiscipline the school reserves the right to expel the student with or without warning.
14. Simple wrist watches are allowed only for students of Std. X.
15. Students are not allowed to carry cell phones, i-pods and electronic gadgets to school. Any student found using them will be fined Rs.1,500/- and the same will be confiscated.
16. Students not availing the school transport will not be allowed to enter from gate 1.
17. Pupils are not only answerable to the school authorities for their conduct in school, but also for their general behaviour outside. Bullying, fighting and disruptive behaviour will result in strict disciplinary action.
- * **18. Any pupil who is persistently defiant by violating the school rules or is guilty of malpractice in connection to examination or who in the opinion, of the School Committee has a negative influence on his fellow pupils, may be expelled permanently or suspended from school for a specific period. (Secondary School Code : Government of Maharashtra)**
19. Applying Mehendi is not allowed. No fancy hair style/haircuts will be permitted. Accessories like rings, fancy clips, long earrings etc. are not allowed.

LIBRARY :

1. The school library provides a collection of reading material which includes encyclopedias, study books on all subjects, fiction books, general knowledge books, magazines etc.
2. Bags are not allowed & strict silence must be maintained in the library.
3. Late fees of Rs. 5/- per day will be charged even if the student is late in returning the book by one day.

TRANSPORT FACILITY :

1. The school management has its own buses specially designed for school students with seat belts, wireless system a well equipped medical kit, emergency exit from where children can easily step out, in case of any eventuality for their safety and security.
2. Students are collected from and dropped at stipulated points and not from their residence.
3. The bus routes are subject to change. Students using the bus service one way, will be charged for both the ways.
4. School buses are compulsory for all the students, except those who come walking or by their own vehicles. Auto rickshaws and private contractors are not permitted for safety reasons. Bus fees will depend on the distance travelled, which is payable for all the 12 months of the academic year. (on a half yearly basis from June to November & December to May of the respective academic year.)
5. Std X student must pay 9 months fees at the start of the 1st semester.
6. If the fee is not paid within the first fifteen days of the semester, a fine will be levied.
7. Parents/servants are not allowed to travel or board the school bus under any circumstances.
8. **Bus service will be regular and punctual as far as possible. In case of a break-down due to some unforeseen circumstances, parents are requested to arrange for the conveyance.**

9. If a parent has any complaint he/she must contact the school office and not confront the drivers, conductors or students directly.
10. The school is in no way responsible for any mishap or injury to a student while using the school bus. This is only a facility provided by the school.
11. **In case of hike in diesel rates the school will hold the right to increase the bus fees.**
12. **Fees once paid, will not be refunded.**
13. **To discontinue the bus service for the next academic year, parents must intimate by filling the forms available with the bus department by 31st of March.**

Students travelling by school bus are expected to be well behaved and courteous. Anyone found misbehaving will be deprived of the bus facility.
